Due to the lingering pandemic, we are having an **OUTDOOR** performance at The 50 Acre Park (right across from the EPCHS Sports Complex) for our recital again this year. In case of inclement weather, we will perform **INSIDE** of the EPCHS Sports Complex on the tennis courts.

Since we are not in an indoor auditorium, we are not requiring tickets. However, the Park District has asked us to limit the number of quests due to Covid, so please *limit your quests to family only*. The show will be professionally recorded and the videos of each class will be pieced together so we have a very special showcase of "Live, Love, Dance!"

SCHEDULE — (Performance Schedule attached)

- Each class will perform within a scheduled time slot. There will be 3 to 5 classes for each designated time slot. The Performance Schedule is not necessarily the order in which classes perform during their time slot, so arrive with enough time to be ready to go at the start of the performance time slot in case your child's class performs first.
- Be prepared to be there for an hour or less. You can leave after your child's performance, or you can watch other classes perform.
- If your child is in multiple classes, he/she may have multiple performance time slots.

SEATING and SOCIAL DISTANCING

- All families are asked to sit in a group distanced from other families. We will have limited number of chairs available, so please bring your own lawn chairs or blanket for your family. If the performance is held inside you will need to bring your own chairs/blankets also.
- Students will enter and exit the stage from their family seating area.

MASKS AND SOCIAL DISTANCING

- Masks are required for all staff, students, and audience members. MDA will determine closer to the recital date if dancers can remove their masks to perform.
- Each dancer will be distanced six feet from each other when not changing formations. The dance floors will be marked so each dancer knows where to stand.

PERFORMANCE

- All students should remain in their family seating area before and after each performance. Students will enter and exit the stage from their family seating area.
- Pre-Ballet 2 and 3 should arrive in the costume/accessories as indicated on the letter enclosed in their costume bag.
- Upper level students should arrive in the costume of their first class listed on the Performance Schedule.
- Students must have an adult help change costumes, accessories, and shoes (if required). Adults must help manage their child's social distancing. Due to Covid, there will be no class volunteers helping the students. If a student in advanced levels 2 and 3 can handle their own garments in changing, an adult is not required, but is optional.
- · All students who have complete costume changes in which the bodice is changed should wear a skin-tone undergarment (available through MDA) under their costume for easy changing. We will have portable, one-person tents for students to change in. Students can change in their parents' cars if preferred.
